Program Updates

- Q2 FY21 Implementation Plans were due to Treasury by March 31st
 - Thank you for your timely submissions!
 - These submissions will be reflected on your Q2 Scorecard
 - Q3 FY21 Implementation Plans are due by June 30th
- Release 4.1
 - Seller Facilitated Orders (SFO) functionality
 - Agencies will be able to assign Subordinate Groups, select Document Inheritance Indicator (DII) and view the Org Structure from the GT&C.
 - Improved Accessibility (508 Compliance)
 - Successfully deployed to Production (March 30th) and QA-C (April 9th)



Program Updates Continued

7600A/B Forms

- Revised 7600A/B Forms and Instructions posted to the Fiscal Service webpage
- Also posted a Statutory Authority Job Aid
- Forms will be frozen until post mandate
- A meeting will be scheduled to discuss these revisions

TFM Chapter 4700 Updates Underway

- First & Second Draft Reviews completed. Draft submitted to GAO on April 12th
- Treasury is considering both policy & system controls to address Measuring
 & Enforcing G-Invoicing Compliance
 - New section added to Appendix 8
- Annual publication June 2021



Release 4.2

- Performance and Order APIs built to June 2020 specifications
- GT&C Workflow functionality
- QAF Deployment scheduled for May to allow ERP Software Vendors to test their solutions




Production Deployment tentatively scheduled for this summer (late June)
