Constructive Order Acceptance (COA)

Objective:

- G-Invoicing to accommodate GSA Rent by offering COA
 - Seller to supply <u>all</u> required Order data, but buyer has opportunity to approve/reject
 - Support other business applications with a similar use case

Changes needed:

- 1. Partners choose Business Application (COA) on GT&C
- 2. New validation rules applied to Seller Facilitated Orders (SFO)
- 3. Build the COA feature to open Orders after 7 days

What's not changing:

- SFO process flow (aka, State Diagram)
- Requesting agency may provide all their SFO data elements
- Requesting agency given opportunity to approve Orders
- Requesting agency may dispute the charges
- Requesting agency closes all Orders



General Terms and Conditions

- New data element: Business Application on GT&C
 - "BizApp" allows G-Invoicing to apply conditional logic to govern GT&Cs and Orders without having to add new data elements to the GT&C
 - Example: BizApp = 'Constructive Order Acceptance'
 - COA Days = 7
 - This will not be added to the GT&C, but will be viewable there
 - Order Originating Partner Indicator (on GT&C) = Servicing and cannot be changed
 - Assisted Acquisition Indicator (on GT&C) = No and cannot be changed



Changes to GT&C and Order

- Add Business Application (BizApp) to GT&C
 - Affects FIDS, SM&VR, UI, PDF, CSV and XML
- Validation Rules for Seller Facilitated Orders
 - FOB Point must be 'Source' for COA
 - Bona Fide Need, etc. may be supplied by seller
 - Requesting TAS may be modified by the servicing agency
- Constructive Order Acceptance
 - Seller Facilitated Orders will move to open status
 - Wait seven (7) full days after creation
 - No action if already fully approved/rejected by requesting agency
 - Requesting approver data will indicate COA done by G-Invoicing
 - System rejects Order if required data not provided
 - COA applies for new or modified Orders



Billing for BizApp COA (GSA Rent)

- No changes to current Performance functionality
- For rent, GSA will submit Delivered/Performed once the Order is approved
 - Performance Quantity will equal the Schedule Quantity
 - Performance Quantity may represent summarized amount
 - GSA will post detail charges on Rent on Web
- Requesting agency optionally submits Received/Accepted
 - Same quantity to confirm the amount settled
 - Different quantity to dispute the amount settled
- Adjustments may occur, possibly years later
 - Orders may have to be reopened via Modification (initiated by GSA)
 - Adjustments must be charged to open Accounting Period



Implementation Details

- The following slides document what needs to be changed in published
 G-Invoicing specifications in order to implement this new feature
- Implementation details are provided so that:
 - Product Owner(s) can confirm detailed business requirements
 - Development team(s) can visualize changes needed to support new features
- At this time, we cannot predict when development of this feature will begin, when it will be released into QA or Production, or in which release it will be included
- When the time comes to begin work on this feature, these details will be added to the specifications, a release will be targeted, and API specifications will be republished
- One of the implementation details described below is a move from XML to JSON payloads for APIs involving GT&Cs, Orders and Performance
 - Future (post-mandate) APIs will only support JSON payloads
 - Note: Newer APIs (e.g., Pull Org, Remittance) are already in JSON format



Changes to FIDS and SM&VR

- GT&C Federal Intragovernmental Data Standards
 - Business Application

New data element

- A particular product line or type of operation, typically documented on an agreement between two business partners, and used to control attributes of that agreement and/or characterize transactions occurring under that agreement.
- BizApp; type string; max length 100 characters
- Updated via Modification; N/A if Orders exist
- GT&C System Mapping and Validation Rules
 - Business Application allowed values:
 - Standard
 - Apply GT&C validation rules as currently published
 - Constructive Order Acceptance
 - Order Originating Partner Indicator set to Servicing and cannot be changed
 - Assisted Acquisition Indicator set to No and cannot be changed

Note: There will be other BizApp values, but they are described in other feature specifications

Appendix D: Constructive Order Acceptance (COA)

new Appendix

For specific Business Applications and under certain conditions, the G-Invoicing system will move an Order to open (REC) status to support timely billing by the servicing agency

- Conditions upon which to constructively accept an Order:
 - COA Days (an attribute of the Business Application selected on the Order's GT&C) is numeric (0-n)
 - Order is in SP2 (shared with partner 2) or P2A (pending partner 2 approval) status
 - The full number of COA Days have elapsed since the Order was last put into SP2 status by the servicing agency
 - All required data is valid, otherwise the Order will be rejected by the System
 - Validation errors are returned in the Rejection Reason
- COA takes place shortly after midnight
- A constructively accepted Order will have the following characteristics:
 - Status = 'REC' (open)
 - Any missing approval date will be set to the current date
 - Any missing approver name will be set to 'System'
 - Any missing approver title will be set to 'Constructive Order Acceptance'
 - Any missing approver e-mail address will be set to 'Do not reply'
 - Any missing approver phone number will be set to 'Do not call'

Note: There are two approvals required for each partner (i.e., program and funding officials). COA will supply the missing data for one or two Partner 2 approvers.



Other Changes to External APIs

- API Payloads
 - New data elements supporting new (post-mandate) features:
 - will be available in JSON format
 - will <u>not</u> be added to XML schemas
 - All new (post-mandate) API versions will carry JSON payloads
 - Current (pre-mandate) API versions using XML payloads will be supported until either:
 - 1. all clients have migrated to new versions, or
 - 2. end-of-life date has been reached (following announcement and waiting period)
- Business Application (BizApp) will only be available in JSON format
 - Pull GT&C API version 3_0

new API version

- For rent, this puts GSA's customers on older API version at a <u>slight</u> disadvantage
 - GSA Rent GT&Cs are still recognizable by the servicing agency, title, requesting agency tracking number (aka, occupancy agreement), etc.
 - But they won't be able to see that BizApp is 'Constructive Order Acceptance'



Other Changes (not related to APIs)

- GT&C User Interface
 - Business Application will be added to UI under Header/Detail
 - Provide option to display attributes of a Business Application
 - For example, for Constructive Order Acceptance:
 - COA Days = 7
 - Order Originating Partner Indicator = Servicing
 - Assisted Acquisition Indicator = No
- Add new Business Application data element to:
 - Print GT&C (PDF)
 - GT&C Exports (CSV)
 - Performance Report



October Survey Results

- 1. When doing business with GPO after Oct 1, 2022 Are you willing and able to wait for EZ Process to be implemented for procurement vehicles that are low dollar/high volume? Or does your agency want to follow the standard G-Invoicing process for all work submitted to GPO? Select one of the following three responses:
 - a) Our agency is interested in the EZ Process for all GPO work under \$10K –
 GPO work will continue in the current state.
 - 35% of responders indicated this was their preference.
 - b) Our agency is interested in the EZ Process for only specific programs under \$10k.
 - 23% of responders indicated this was their preference.
 - Our agency is NOT interested in the EZ Process and will be using the standard GINV process for all Orders with GPO.
 - 42% of responders indicated this was their preference.



October Survey Results Continued

- 2. Which Post-Mandate feature would you like to know more information about?
 - In-Flight Orders (15 votes)
 - Low Dollar Purchases/7600-EZ (12 votes)
 - Allow Performance against an open Order while it's being modified (11 votes)
 - Allow Order Maintenance while GT&C is being modified (9 votes)
 - Validate Line Item Code using Product Service Code (8 votes)
 - Allow agencies to assign new TASes to Orders prior to Oct 1st (7 votes)
 - Budget Object Class Required for Requesting Agency (7 votes)
 - Allow Zero Quantity Refund (6 votes)
 - Correct rounding issues (6 votes)
 - Several others with 5 votes or fewer.



October Survey Results Continued

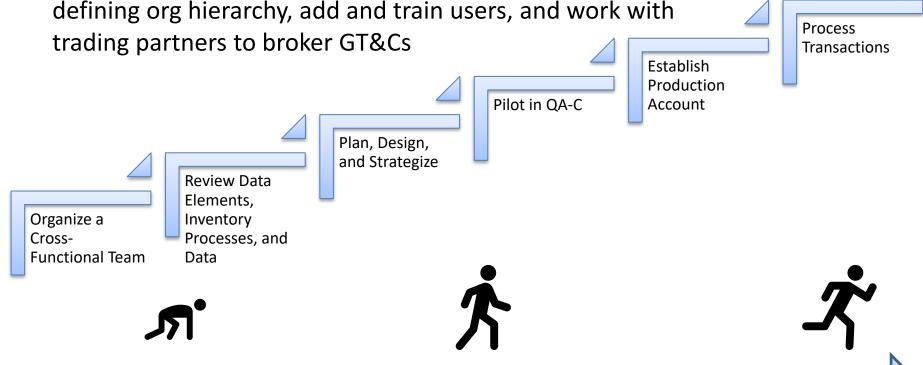
- 3. Do you have any significant concerns with the Draft Thresholds Ranges on Slide 18? If so, please explain your concerns
 - A few of the notable concerns shared with us include:
 - a) Older FY activity that didn't qualify as In-Flight activity billed directly through IPAC post-mandate impacting FY24/25 metrics
 - b) Handling of Revolving Funds with no BPOA
 - c) Not all agency business lines will be fully compliant by the mandate and how that will impact TP's ability to meet the thresholds
 - d) ERP vendor's timely/successful interface development
 - e) Challenge of reconciling IFO's in FY24/25 while trying to convert them while also establishing new Orders in G-Invoicing.

91% of Significant Entities have established production accounts and are actively preparing for GT&Cs

With the Mandate just over 10 months out, all agencies should now focus on defining org hierarchy, add and train users, and work with **Process**

Post-Mandate Work Underway

- Working on post-mandate API Specifications
- Proposed features:
 - In-Flight Orders
 - Low Dollar Purchases (7600-EZ)
 - Constructive Order Acceptance (GSA Rent)
 - Allow Performance against an open Order while it's being modified
 - Allow Order Maintenance while GT&C is being modified
 - Revert a modified GT&C or Order back to open status
 - Allow Zero Quantity Refund
 - Prohibit non-printable characters
 - Budget Object Class Required (Requesting Agency Only)
 - Validate Line Item Code using Product Service Code
 - Correct rounding issues
 - Allow agencies to assign new TASes to Orders prior to Oct 1st





Upcoming Release Information

- Release 4.4 next production deployment tentatively planned for Feb 2022
 - GT&C Workflow by Org Group
 - Continue improving user API efficiencies
 - Undelivered Balance enhancements
 - Addressed issues when two Accounting Periods are open
 - More efficient GT&C Summary List page
 - New Report Menu and Performance Report
 - New Order Supervisor Roles created





Upcoming Program Objectives

- Develop and Publish Post-Mandate Enhancement Specifications
 - Including: Low Dollar (7600-EZ), In-Flight Order Upload and Constructive Order Acceptance
 - Will NOT be included as enhancements in our next production deployment (Post-Mandate)
- G-Invoicing Program Guide Under review for updates
 - Guide for Basic Accounting and Reporting
 - Targeting a December 2021 publication
- G-Invoicing Rules of Engagement Guide Under review for updates
 - Details the appropriate protocols for entities to follow within the application and leading up to the implementation of G-Invoicing
 - Targeting a December 2021 publication
