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
JULY'S NAVY CASH SAILOR OF THE MONTH

Be advised, questions on Navy Cash issues should **NOT** go through Navy311. To get a more expeditious resolution, all members should contact the shipboard Disbursing Officer. The Disbursing Officer and usually the lead PS/SH are the only personnel authorized to contact the Navy Cash Central Support Unit (CSU) to open a case. Please inform your IT personnel that they should contact you to open a Navy Cash case vice submitting a ticket with Navy311.

Only authorized persons on each ship are authorized to contact the Navy Cash CSU. If a member has a question about their own personal Navy Cash account they should either contact Navy Cash Customer Service Center (CSC) by calling 1-866-362-8922 or emailing navycash@ezpaymt.com.

As for some of the other issues that come from the Fleet as Navy Cash issues, below is a brief list of who should be contacted for assistance:

- MMPA or Master Military Pay Accounts - PSD Afloat or DFAS-CL
- ROM II or ROM III - Fleet Assist Team
- Individual bank questions - the member should be directed to contact their own bank.
- If a member has transferred from an Afloat unit, they must contact the Disbursing Officer assigned to their former unit.
