




Federal Agency Migration Evaluation Quick Guides

Phase 1: Migration Evaluation

Overview of the Phase

The purpose of this phase is to determine if a customer agency needs to migrate its financial system(s).



Key Considerations

- ☑ FIT will assign a liaison to all customer agencies migrating financial systems. The liaison will provide guidance and oversight throughout the Federal Agency Migration Evaluation (FAME) process.
- ☑ A customer agency must consider migrating its financial system to a Federal Shared Service Provider (FSSP) if the migration request is approved. Transaction processing and mixed systems will be migrated at the discretion of the customer agency.
- ☑ During each phase of the FAME process, FIT reviews customer agency artifacts, makes a recommendation to OMB, and OMB provides concurrence/non-concurrence. If a customer agency would like to appeal FIT's recommendation and/or OMB's decision, it may do so by working with FIT to escalate it to the Executive Oversight Committee within the Financial Marketplace Governance structure.
- ☑ Though most major process steps noted above may conclude before the next one begins, depending on the circumstances, some steps may execute concurrently.
