Subject: November 21, 2016 SPS Release (RelP 21.0.0)

1. Introduction

This document explains “What’s New” with the next release of the Secure Payment System (SPS RelP 21.0.0) for Data Entry Operators and Certifying Officers user roles. The new release offers support to additional Window Support and bug fixes. This document also contains information about upcoming changes to SPS, and the list of supported operating systems (O/S) and Java Plug-ins.

The new release is expected to be in production on Monday November 21, 2016. There is no new Installation CD with this release. The Install CD dated October 2015 is still valid and current.

2. SPS Support for Microsoft Windows Operating Systems

Starting with this SPS release, the list of supported Operating Systems is extended to Microsoft Windows 7, Windows 8.1 and Windows 10. The exact detail of this support is as follows: Windows 7 is fully supported. Window 8.1 now has minimal support. Windows 10 is supported for the basic SPS functionality on Desktop, Laptop and Tablet form factors.

3. Java Plug-in version support for SPS

Since SPS is no longer accessible from a Browser, there is no dependency on Java Web Plug-in versions installed (if any).

4. Upcoming Changes to SPS

The next two releases of SPS (scheduled for June and August of 2017,) will provide functionality to allow compatible Agency PIV Badges to be used for accessing SPS along with other enhancements and bug fixes. These changes will be shared with the SPS User community before the release dates.
